Firearm Inventory Checklist

Document what you own before theft, fire, flood, an insurance claim, or an estate transition forces you to reconstruct it from memory.

Tip: Do not keep the only copy of your inventory in the gun safe. If the safe is stolen or damaged, your documentation may disappear with the collection. Keep a secure off-site or encrypted digital copy.
